STUDENT LEADERSHIP RECOGNITION

The student will be received at the annual Awards Gala and Dinner on Thursday, February 28, 2019 at the annual FEO Conference. We respectfully encourage the student to be prepared to attend the Awards Gala and Dinner.

- The student is entitled to two (2) complimentary dinner tickets
- Student(s) will be recognized on the FEO website with an image and short story
- The student will receive a bursary in the amount of \$500.

CRITERIA

- 1) The student must be enrolled in an accredited Event Program, full or part-time.
- 2) Student must meet a minimum of 80% GPA.

- 3) The school must be a member of Festivals and Events Ontario.

IN ORDER TO QUALIFY FOR THE AWARD, THE STUDENT MUST PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING:

- 1) Three(3) examples of demonstrated leadership and influence within their academic year. For example: Chaired a committee, student mentoring etc.
- 2) Three(3) examples of event related experience either volunteering or working within the community and/or industry throughout the academic year. Explain how the volunteer/work experience benefitted both the community/event and the student. For example: New process implemented to benefit the community, new skill learned by the student.
- 3) Two(2) letters of reference from professor/college and one(1) letter of reference from employer. The employer letter does not need to be industry related (it is a letter of reference only).
- 4) A copy of your first term report indicating a minimum 80% GPA.
- 5) A resume highlighting event planning experience.
- 6) A 500 word essay that reflects the value of association membership, networking and leadership development as it applies to career goals and aspirations.
